

## Active Assailant

This 8 hour course is designed for the first responding patrol officers to incidents involving active assailants. The tactics taught are applicable to active shooters within schools, businesses, daycare systems, malls or large buildings with public access.

### Topics covered include:

- Team formation for dynamic entries
- Weapon retention and defensive tactics
- Room clearing techniques
- Combat firearm techniques
- Hostage situations and barricaded individuals
- Force on force scenario training utilizing Simunitions

### Required Equipment:

Duty belt without weapons (no pistol, baton, OC, Taser), department squad, department ballistic shield (if possible), flashlight.

### Optional Equipment:

Ballistic helmets, knee pads, elbow pads, department issue or personal Simunitions equipment including FFX conversion pistols and long guns, protective helmets, throat and groin protection, gloves, long sleeved shirt, bulletproof vest, and water to stay hydrated. It is highly recommended you bring a lunch due to time constraints.
